

# Plumber Exemption (SB 687) vs. Level D Certification as a Well Contractor Guide for Pump Installers

## SB 687 Plumber Exemption

### Requirements:

**Licensed Plumber** (actual licensed plumber, not sub-licensee)  
(Class 1- Unlimited, Class II- Limited)  
2 years experience  
pass 250-question open-book exam

annual renewal:  
\$125 renewal fee  
6 hours Continuing Education  
\*\*\*for exemption, also need continuing education relating to well seals & disinfection, to be taken within 2 years prior to performing the well contractor activity. Plumber must maintain this documentation.\*\*\*

Must be present on site while the well contractor activities are being performed.

### Activities Allowed:

Breaking/Installing well seal & well disinfection  
**for the purpose of**  
installation, replacement or repair of a well pump or  
pumping equipment within or near the well.

Advertising Opportunities: Licensed by the State to work on household plumbing

## Level D Certification as a Well Contractor

### Level D certified well contractor

6 months experience  
pass 50-question open book exam

annual renewal:  
\$100 renewal fee  
8 hours continuing education

Must be present on site while the well contractor activities are being performed.

Breaking/Installing well seal & well disinfection.  
(**no limit** by purpose)  
...can be relating to down-hole camera work  
...can disinfect as part of routine well maintenance  
...can disinfect well as part of home sale requirements  
...water system operator would use to disinfect well water supply  
...can install well seal & disinfect on newly constructed well  
...can change out a well pump and disinfect the well  
...etc.

Licensed by the State to work on wells
