

Finding Continuing Education

Please refer to NCAC Chapter 27- Well Contractor Certification Rules, Section .0800 for the requirements and other information pertaining to continuing education.

Certified well contractors are required to earn **8** hours of continuing education (PDH) by the renewal deadline (June 30) each year. If more than 8 hours of continuing education are earned during a certification period, up to 8 of the extra hours may be carried over to the next certification period. ***Selection of courses and activities which meet the requirements of 15A NCAC 27 .0820 is the responsibility of the certified well contractor.***

Courses or activities must maintain, improve, or expand the skills and knowledge related to the practice of well contractor activities in order for a well contractor to receive credit. A course will not be recommended for approval if the obvious intent is primarily the sale or promotion of a product. Programs by vendors may be considered if the obvious intent of the program is primarily training. No sales of a product should be connected with an approved course.

It is the policy of the Commission to deny course credit if the same course was already taken and credited during the same certification period (eg.- Hazwoper taken Sept. 08 and again Nov. 08), or if the same exact course was already taken at the same workshop (ex.- Geothermal class taken Sat. at Jubilee, then repeat taken again Sun.)
